









Dear parishioners of the Russian Orthodox Church Outside Russia in the Western European and German Dioceses,

With the blessing of His Eminence Mark, His Eminence Irenei, and His Eminence Hiob, it has been decided to hold a pan-European conference of Orthodox youth of our Church in the autumn of 2026. The important goals of this conference are to strengthen ties among the youth of the two european ROCOR dioceses and beyond, to reinforce their role in the life of the church, and to collaborate in the development of new youth projects. Such a conference is a unique opportunity for young people to unite in common prayer and spiritual work and is the first of its kind here in Europe.

A small hotel in a Catholic monastery in the countryside near Florence was chosen as the venue. During the five days of the conference, participants will be able to:

- Learn a lot from spiritual conversations
- Gain useful skills and friends during master classes and group projects
- Ask clergy members questions that are important to them
- Enjoy the Italian countryside and visit landmarks of Christian culture
- Participate in services at the beautiful Church of the Nativity of Christ and St.
 Nicholas the Wonderworker in Florence

The event is being organised by a committee consisting of representatives from various youth groups from both dioceses. Most of the committee members already have successful experience in organising All-Abroad and/or diocesan conventions.

Our committee intends to develop a programme for the congress that is as spiritually enriching and fulfilling as possible. At the same time, we want to make it accessible to all representatives of our youth. It is important to us that everyone who aspires to live a truly orthodox life can participate. After all, our youth and our young families are the future of our church. Any financial support for the project from you, as benefactors, would help us to hold the congress in its entirety as planned.
